Instructions for filling out the request form for non-eagle feathers, parts and carcasses:

- 1. Be sure to write neatly, preferably in print except for your signature, and if possible, please use ink.
- 2. Your contact information is important. We will be contacting you throughout the process to ensure that you receive what you are requesting and that it will be sent to the correct address.
- 3. While we can send feathers to a P.O. Box, we will not be able to send carcasses to a P.O. Box. Please include an actual mailing/residential address number if you are requesting a carcass.
- 4. Telephone numbers and e-mail addresses will assist in speeding up the process and help to ensure that you get what you are requesting in a timely manner.
- 5. You must include a copy of your official tribal roll vital record, a copy of a Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB) card, or a letter from your tribal enrollment office that certifies your enrollment in a federally recognized tribe.
- 6. You must be at least eighteen years old to apply for feathers, parts or carcasses.
- 7. Mark or name clearly what species you are requesting. One species per request form.
- 8. You may request as much as the equivalent of one bird carcass per request form.
- 9. If you are printing the request form from the web site, be sure that you print it and sign it with your signature in ink before mailing it back to us. Faxed copies will not be considered.
- 10. Check to be sure all of the information required is included, and mail your request back to the Liberty Wildlife Feather Repository, P.O. Box 14345, Scottsdale, AZ 85267. Call 480-998-5550 if you have questions before sending in your request.
